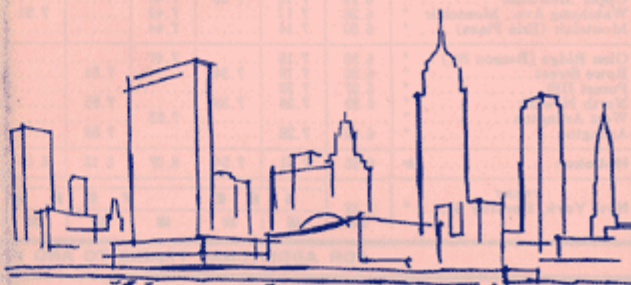

HOW TO REACH ERIE LACKAWANNA TERMINAL HOBOKEN VIA PATH OR BUS

BY PATH (Port Authority Trans-Hudson)—Trains operate to and from Hoboken Terminal and 33rd Street (6th Avenue), uptown New York, running time 14 minutes, and at 23rd Street (6th Avenue), 14th Street (6th Avenue), 9th Street and Christopher Street. Also at Cortlandt Street, downtown New York, running time 10 minutes. Frequent service between PATH stations in New York City and Hoboken, New Jersey.

BY BUS—Public Service Bus No. 63 operates to and from Hoboken Terminal and the Port Authority Bus Terminal, 8th Avenue at 40th & 41st Streets, New York. Running time 20 minutes. Frequent service in each direction.
